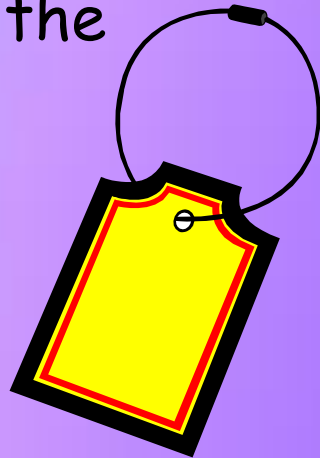
Week 3 News



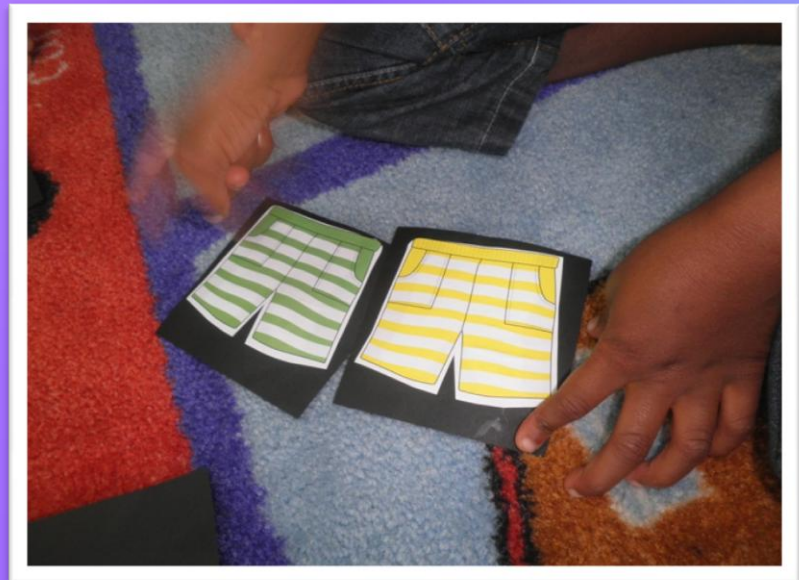

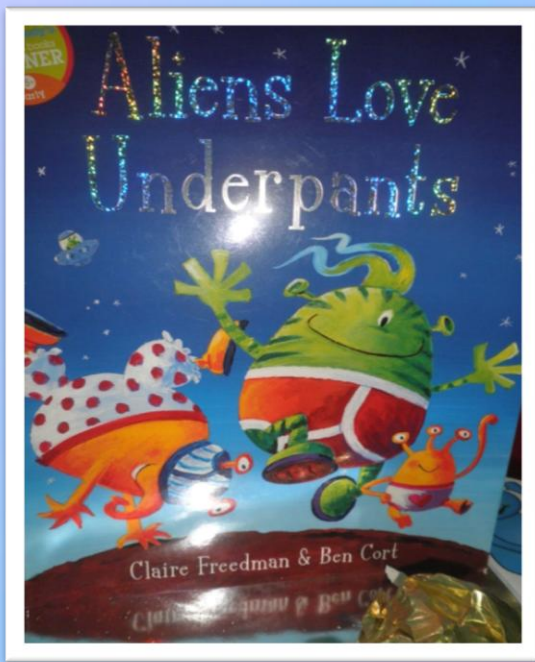




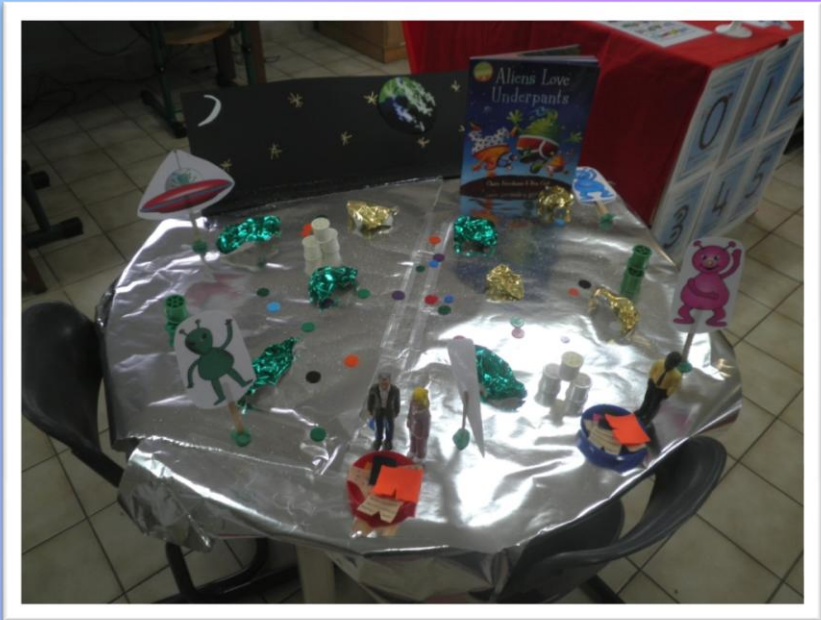
We then helped Fred get some new patterned pants. Why don't you ask us what pattern we did?

“house, spot, house, spot.....”

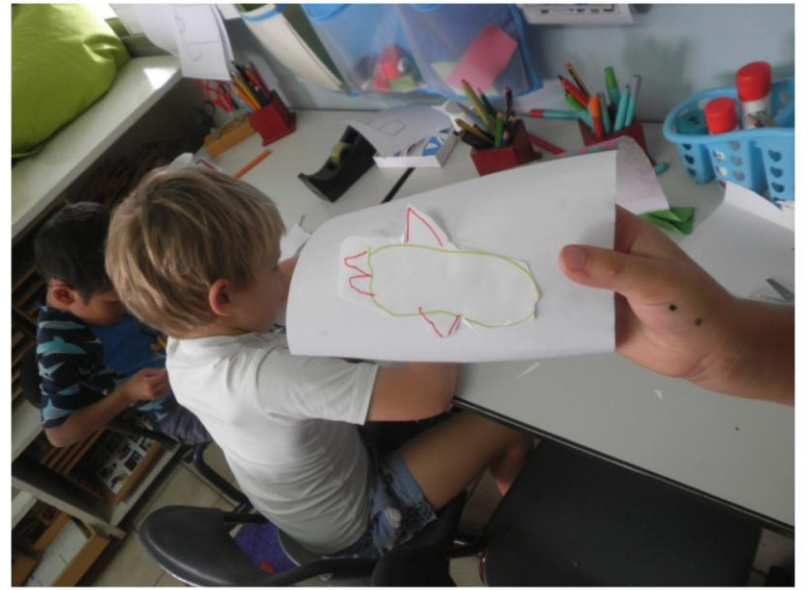




The aliens

LOTS OF LOVELY TALK, SHARING, STORY TELLING AND ENGAGEMENT





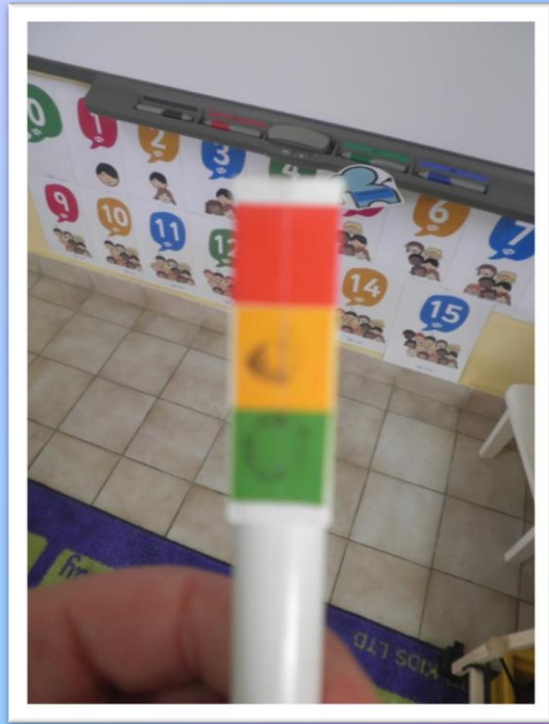
