

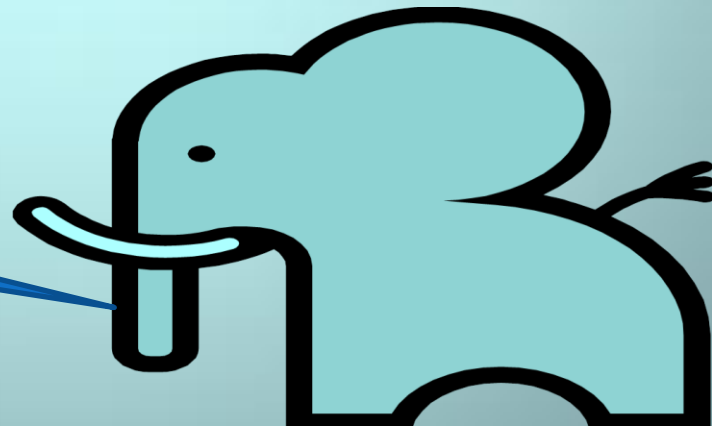
Week 8

Ask us what we found out this week.

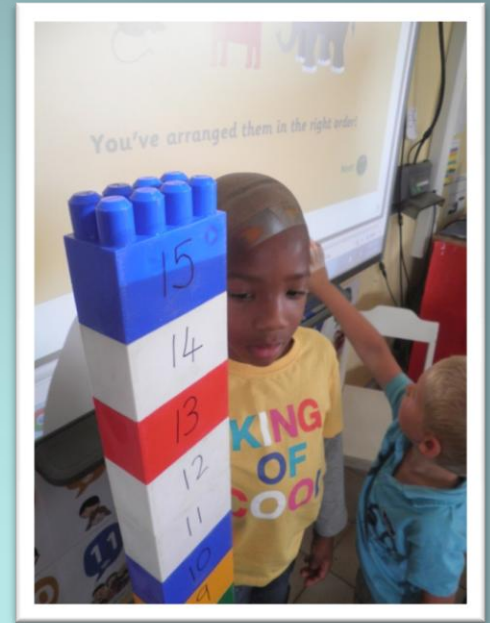
I'm Finding out

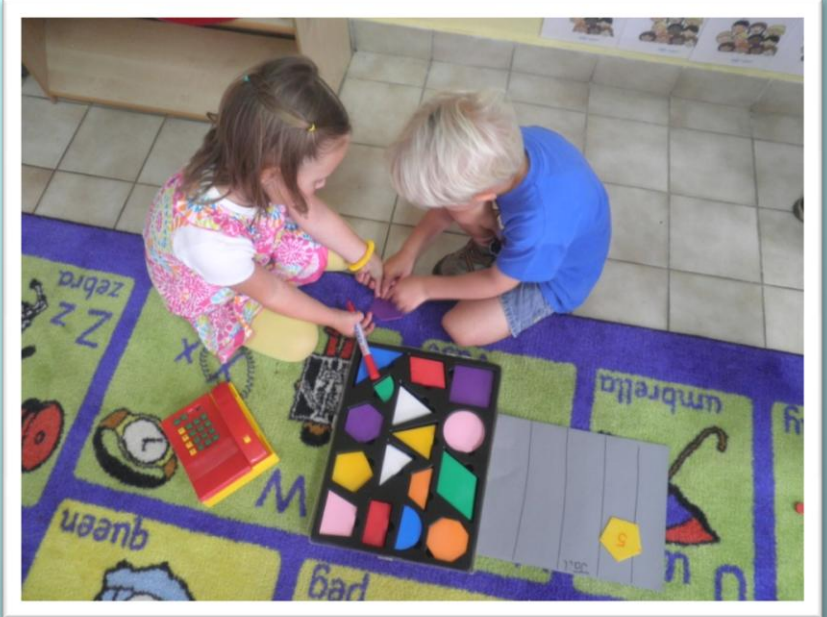

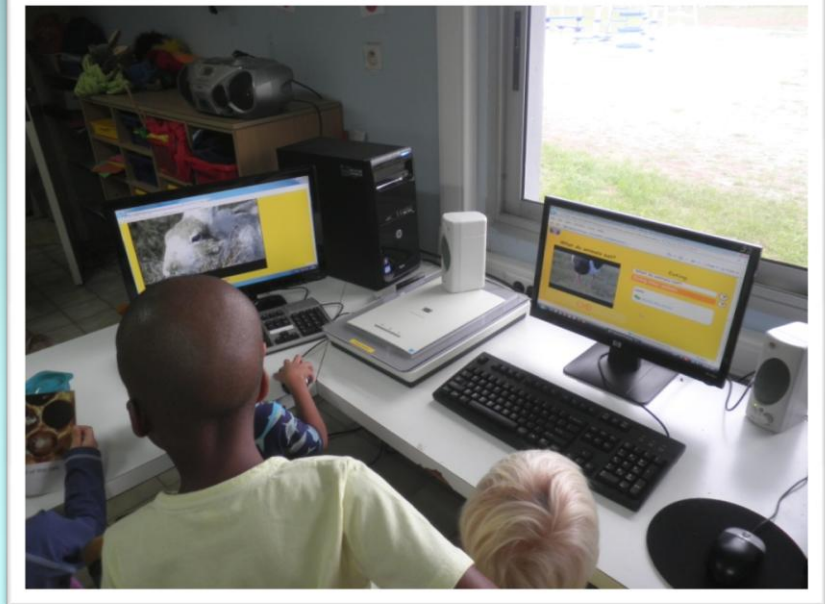
We explored shapes in lots of ways. Sometimes on our own, sometimes with friends and sometimes with Karen.
