

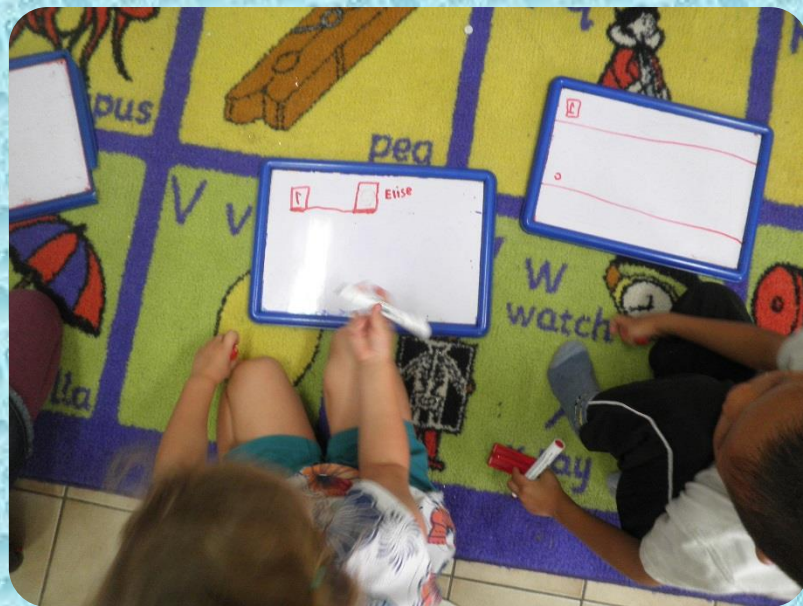
# Treasure Week 3

Primary 1 made their telescopes and then thought about how we would record the instructions for the Nursery children.



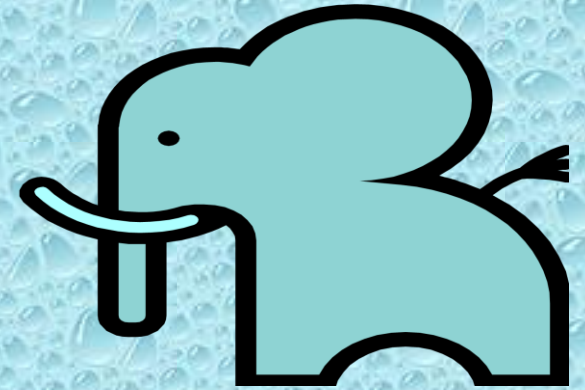
We read our instructions to the Nursery children and they then found the picture to match.



With the instruction complete the Nursery children could then make their own telescopes.



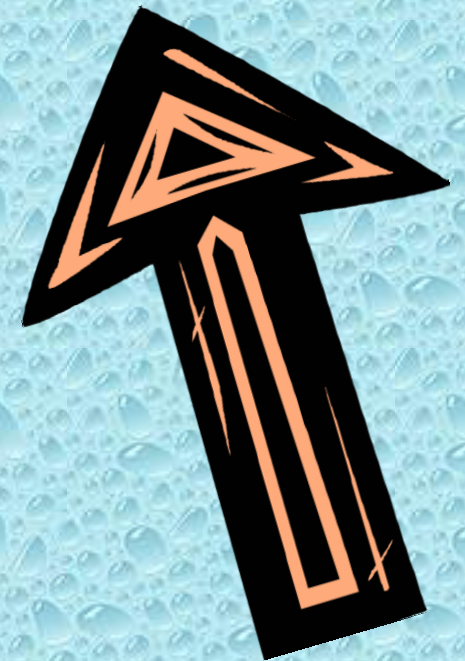
## Finding out Fred

This then led to a good discussion on maps and the need to show where something was. This was a good opportunity to learn about maps- time for Finding out Fred!!!



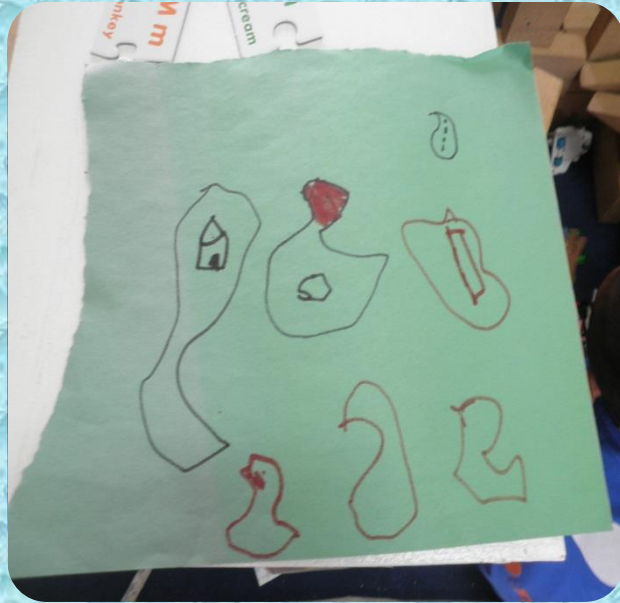
