This week the making table has been very busy. Lots of different eggs and nests have been made.

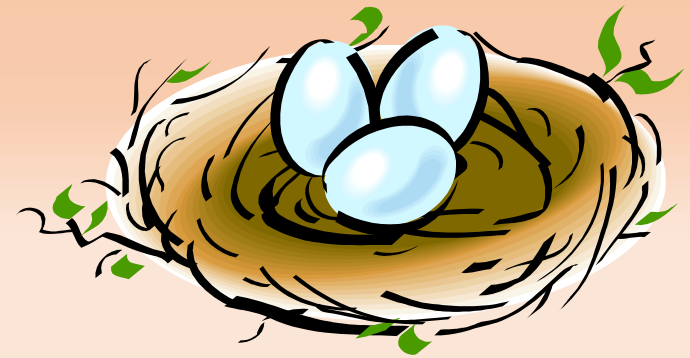


We have also read some stories about eggs. We have enjoyed 'The Odd Egg' and 'Handa's Hen'.

This is how a frog grows and changes. It is called a life cycle.

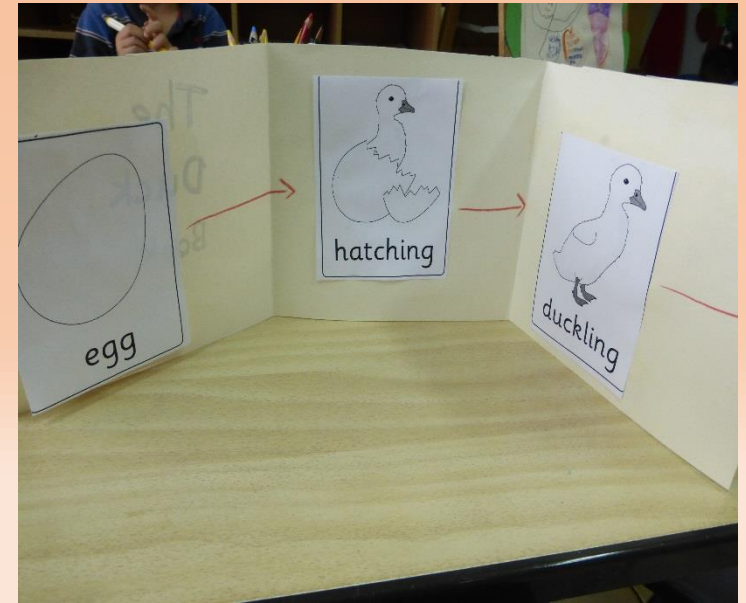

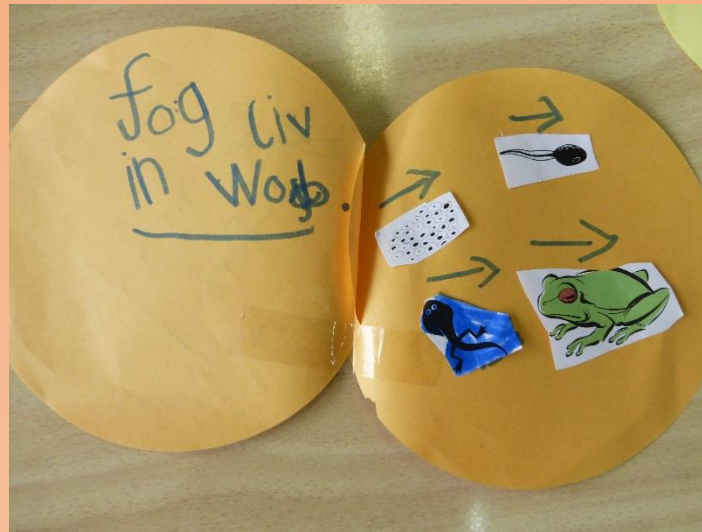


Growing legs and losing their tails
