We copied the colours and shapes from the animal patterns and then we had to do something strange....we had to drop water on our picture...we wondered what would happen!

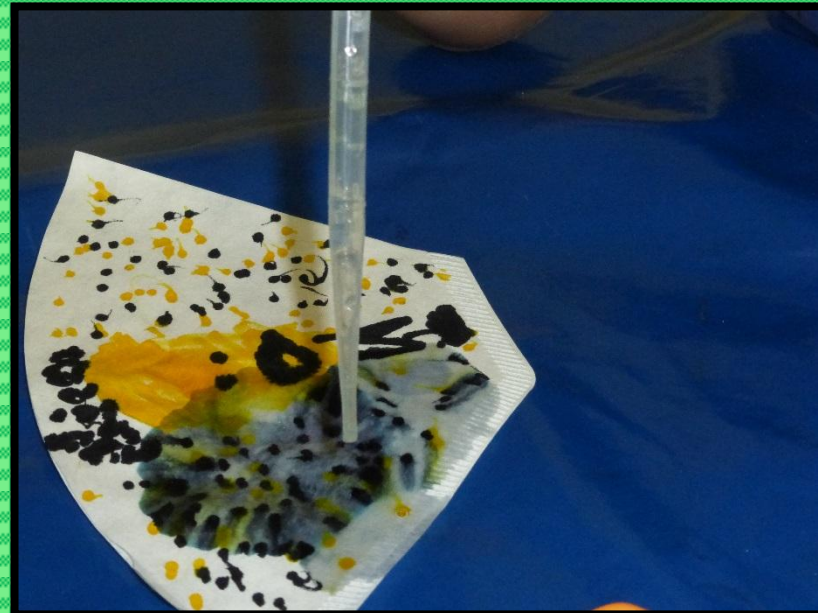


We also made some the animals from the story. We had spotted that the snake, leopard, zebra and peacock all had patterns on them.
