Animals



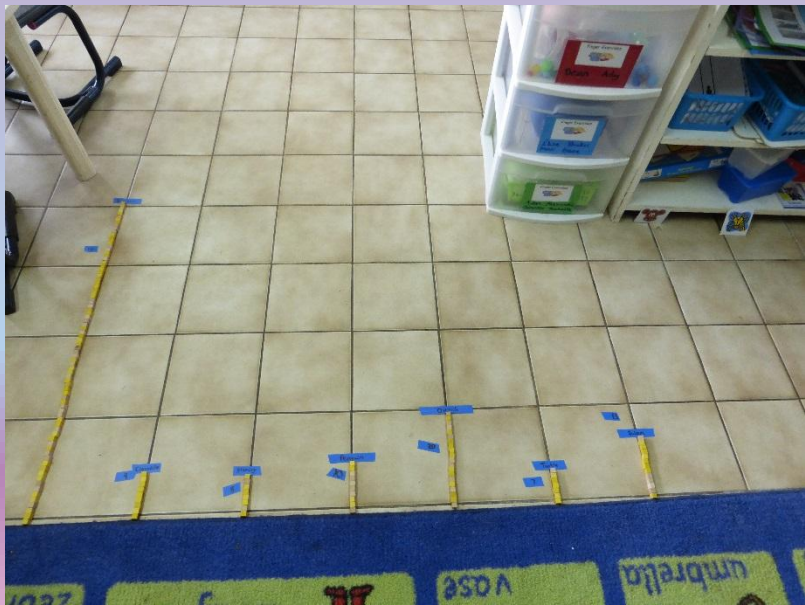
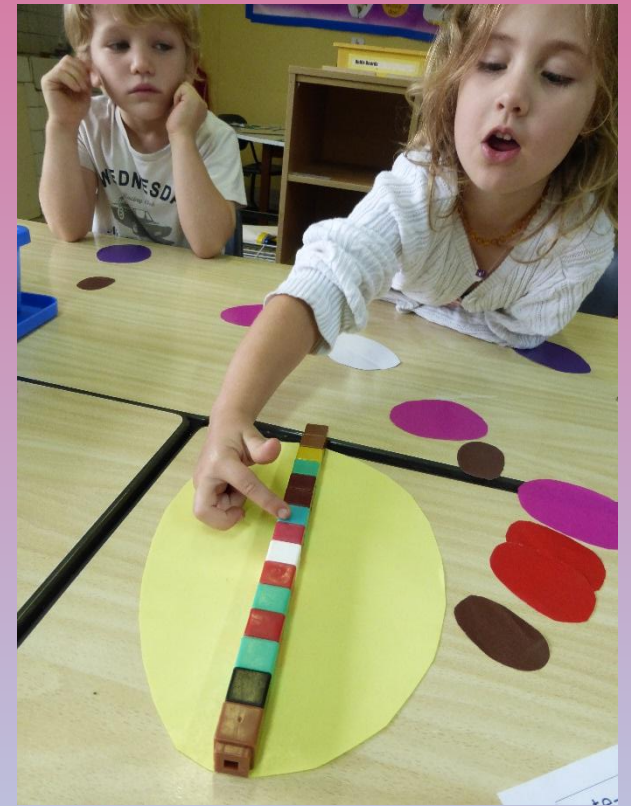

This week we thought a bit more about eggs and we looked at the different sizes of animal eggs. We tried to match the size of the egg to the animal. We used cubes to measure how big their eggs would be. Then we measured our own eggs.





We also estimated, labelled and ordered some eggs. We compared the sizes and had some good 'Talking Tim' questions and discussions about the different sizes.

This week we have also been preparing for our Animal Assembly. We have been learning and singing lots of animal songs and we made posters to show you what songs you would hear. And of course a great opportunity to practise working neatly and sharing too.



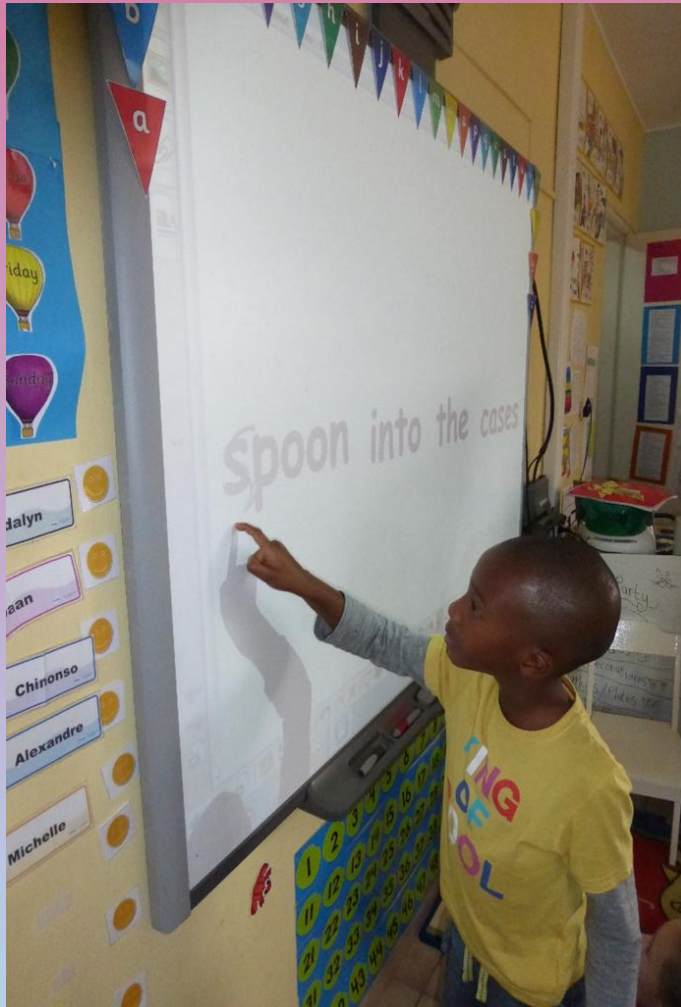


We even did more cooking!! We are experts now and we knew to clean the table and our hands. We are also great at working together to get the different jobs done.



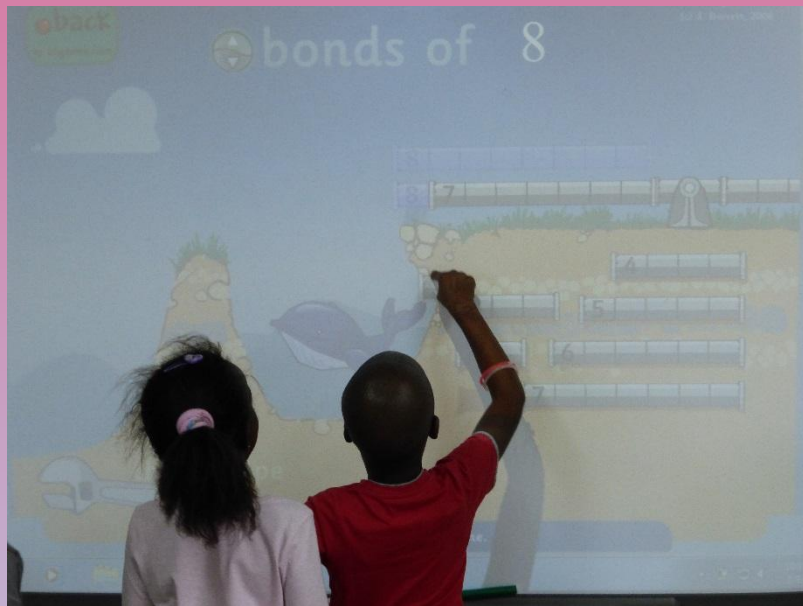
