

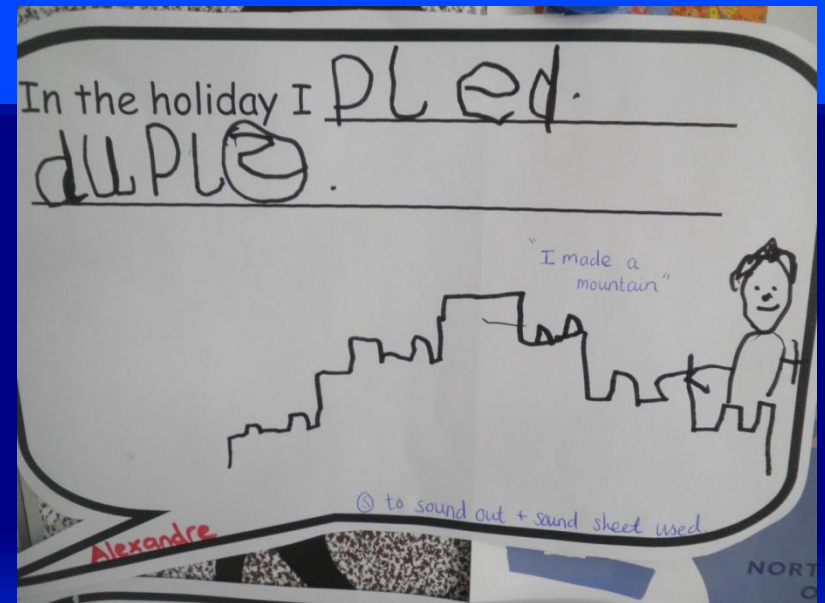
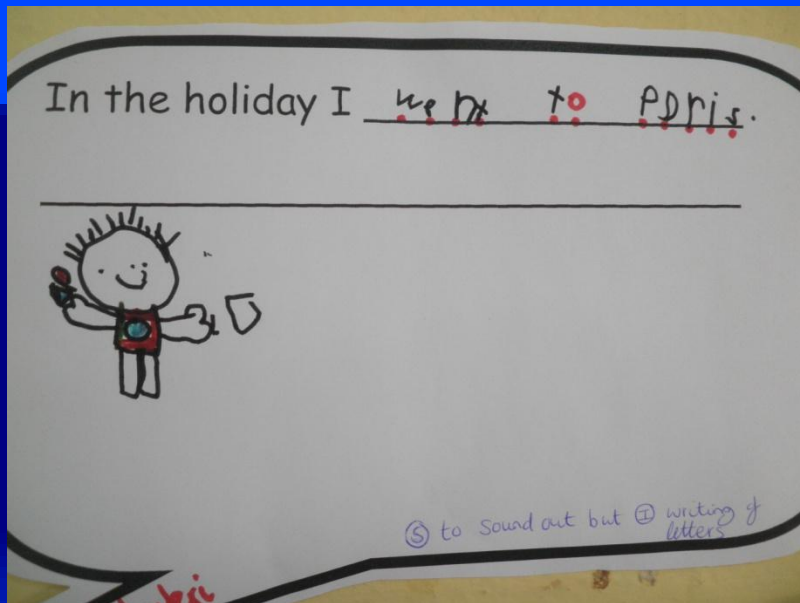
# Primary 1

News

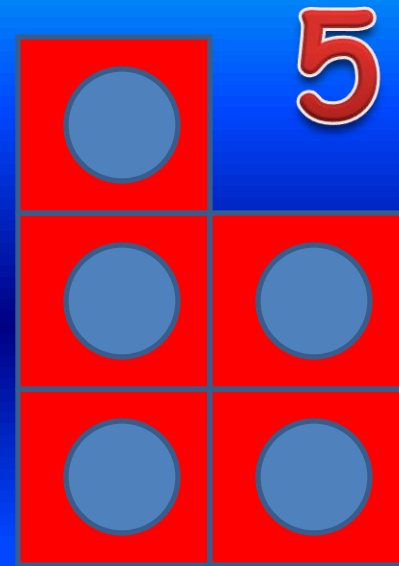
Welcome back. After a slow start we soon had everyone back and as always there is lots to learn in Primary 1. We even enjoyed some new toys and equipment.

We also practised our number skills this week. We used some Numicon and we had to work out what number it showed. We played games to order the Numicon and spot missing numbers.

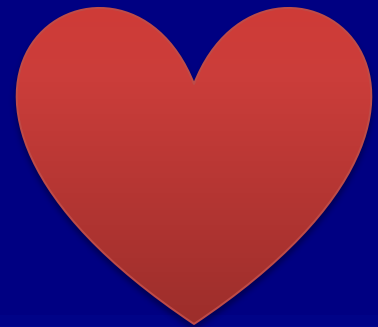




# Ready, Steady, Get in order..
